Qualifications

- The Fundamentals of Fundraising bursaries are available to AFP Golden Horseshoe Chapter members and non-members.
- Applicants can be currently in employed in fundraising, or interested in becoming a fundraising professional.
- Only one application per organization will be accepted.
- AFP Golden Horseshoe will be offering five (5) bursaries for \$300 each for the Fundamentals of Fundraising Course for either the eLearning or in-person formats.

Application Criteria

In order to be considered for a bursary, applicants must:

- Have not received a bursary from AFP GH within the last calendar year (2015);
- Submit this Bursary application form by the deadline of **5:00 p.m. on Friday, March 25, 2016**;
- Demonstrate financial need on the part of their organization and/or the lack of a professional development budget;
- Recipients of bursaries will be required to successfully complete the entire course and submit a brief report at the conclusion of the course;
- Recipients are required to serve on an AFP Golden Horseshoe volunteer committee for a oneyear term.
