

2017 PHILANTHROPY AWARDS - NATIONAL PHILANTHROPY DAY
OUTSTANDING VOLUNTEER FUNDRAISER



Purpose

The AFP Golden Horseshoe Chapter has established this award to be presented to an individual, couple, or family in recognition of their exceptional skills in coordinating and motivating groups of donors and volunteers for fundraising projects for the benefit of non-profit organizations and a commitment to the advancement of philanthropy.

Eligibility & Nomination Criteria

An individual member of AFP-GH Chapter, or the Awards Selection Committee, or the AFP-GH Chapter Board may submit a nomination for this award. The nominee must be notified and in agreement with the nomination process before the application is submitted.

The nomination should include the following information with specific examples from the nominators' organization:

1. Evidence of effective leadership qualities and organizational ability in fundraising campaigns.
2. Description of time, effort, and personal financial commitment.
3. Evidence of success in recruiting and motivating others.
4. Description of fundraising goals achieved by his/her effort.
5. Description of participation in local, national and/or international non-profit organizations.

The recipient cannot be employed professionally in the not-for-profit sector.

Submission Criteria

Each nomination should include the nomination form, the narrative and any supporting documents. The narrative should be no longer than three pages (12-point format with 1" margins). Supporting documents are accepted, but only to support the narrative. No more than six pages of supporting documents are allowed. Do not introduce new information in the supporting documents.

The Awards Selection Committee will review candidates based on the eligibility criteria set out above. If in the judgment of the Committee, no applications meet the criteria, no award will be given in this category.
